

Rules for Entry to the Czech Republic in relation to COVID-19 situation

Dear guest of the St. Martin's Conference,

Considering the ever-worsening epidemiological situation, we have prepared for you a list of valid guidelines issued by the Government of the Czech Republic concerning arrivals to Czechia from the other EU countries.

For the purposes of entry to the Czech Republic you will have to dispose at least one of the following:

1. **Fully vaccinated persons** - fully vaccinated persons are those who have been vaccinated with either AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria), Moderna (Spikevax), Pfizer BioNTech (Comirnaty), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) or Covishield (a vaccine registered for use in the EU or approved for emergency use by the WHO).
2. **Not fully vaccinated persons** - here it is necessary to distinguish between persons from the low risk of infection (green countries), medium risk (orange countries), high risk (red countries), very high risk (dark red countries).

Green countries and orange countries – All persons who:

have stayed more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in countries or territories on the list of countries or territories at low or medium risk of COVID-19,

- a) complete an Arrival Form before entering the Czech Republic ([Arrival Form](#))
- b) undergo an RT-PCR or RAT test before entering the Czech Republic or no later than 5 days after entering the Czech Republic,
- c) produce, upon request at border or residence control, proof of completion of the Arrival Form or written proof that the person concerned is covered by an exemption under this protection measure,

Red countries and dark red countries – All persons who:

have stayed more than 12 hours in the last 14 days in countries or territories on the list of countries or territories at high or very high risk of COVID-19,

- a) complete an Arrival Form before entering the Czech Republic ([Arrival Form](#)),
- b) have an RT-PCR test result before entering the Czech Republic;
- c) provide, on request at border or residence control, proof of completion of the Arrival Form, the result of a SARS-CoV-2 test, or written proof that the person concerned is exempted under this protection measure,

- d) undergo an RT-PCR test between the 5th and 7th day after entering the Czech Republic, unless the public health authority has decided otherwise in exceptional circumstances,
- e) at all times when leaving the place of residence or accommodation, wear a respirator or similar device (without an exhalation valve) fulfilling at least all technical conditions and requirements (for the product), including a filtration efficiency of at least 94 % according to the relevant standards (e.g. FFP2, CN 95), until the negative result of the RT-PCR test referred to in point (d);

Additional information regarding, for example, exceptions (e.g. holders of diplomatic passports traveling to the Czech Republic for purposes of official business, provided that their stay in the territory or outside the territory does not exceed 72 hours etc.) to these approved provisions can be found on the website <https://covid.gov.cz/en/measures/travelling-abroad/arriving-countries-high-risk-covid-19-transmission>.
